

# THAI Sponsor Gift Checklist

<b>Lotus Level – \$350 (or more)</b>	<b>Choose one gift from Group A, one from B and one from C</b>
<b>Emerald Level – \$500 (or more)</b>	<b>Choose any four gifts from all groups</b>

## Group A

- Small metal-framed image of Jivaka, the Buddha, or a Thai reusi. Specify which one in your email.
- Miniature Jivaka, measures appx. 1 inch high. May be used on altars or placed in a case and worn as an amulet
- Jivaka protection amulet: Small Jivaka bronze image in clear plastic case, to be worn around the neck
- Nam ObThai: Bottle of Thai perfume water, for personal use or for offerings
- Country style curry paste: A pouch of home-style northern Thai red curry paste

## Group B

- Thai herbal tea: Blend of lemongrass, ginger, galanga, chrysanthemum, marigold and rose, with a metal tea infuser
- Thai baking/cooking essences: A set of 3 essences and extracts; jasmine, banana, and coconut
- “What’s What in a Wat”: Book about the significance, contents and function of Buddhist temples in Thailand
- Framed photo of Jivaka’s home in Rajgir, India, set in a Thai wooden frame
- Small bronze statue of Jivaka, or the Buddha. Cast bronze, with Thai inscriptions, appx. 3 inches high

## Group C

- Thai essential oil collection: Lemongrass, eucalyptus, ginger, camphor, peppermint
- Book: Thai Healing Arts: Practice, Culture & Spirituality, by Bob Haddad
- Book: Thai Massage: A Traditional Medical Technique, by Richard Gold

- Sample of earth from Jivaka’s home and garden in Rajgir, India. Presented in a bamboo or nickel container from Thailand.
- Thai Buddha amulet in metal case, with chain. Gold color amulet with Buddha image on one side, and Chiang Mai (Doi Suthep) commemoration on the back, in an alpaca case with silver plated chain
